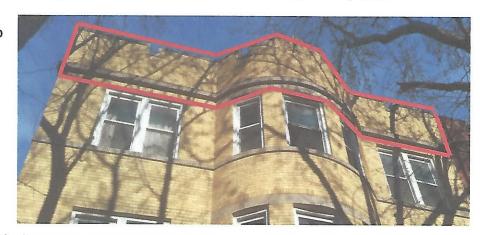

CBR, Inc. agrees to furnish all labor, supervision, materials, and scaffold equipment; to carry Workman's Compensation, Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance; and use every reasonable precaution to protect the public and any adjacent property during the performance of the following work.

Extent of work: Parapet wall rebuilding, Lintel replacement and flashing installation.

 Image shows the South side of the building. All coping stones from the parapet wall will be removed. All parapet wall bricks from the top to the roof level on the roof side and the exterior course to the top of third floor windows will be removed. All metal lintels on third floor windows (2 windows 5 feet long,2 windows, two windows 3 ½ feet and one 4 ½ feet long) will be cleaned of rust and paint or replaced if necessary. Drip edge, flashing (with

termination bar to the backup wall), and weep ropes every 16" will be installed on the new lintels. The wall will be rebuilt with new face brick on the roof side and on the exterior course reusing the old face brick. The original design of the exterior



wall will be recreated. The limestone copings will be reinstalled on the top of the rebuilt parapet wall using 3/8 stainless steel threaded rod to anchor them to the wall. All coping

joints will be finished with NP-1 sealant. New roof flashing will be installed with the termination bar approximately 12" above the surface of the roof.
